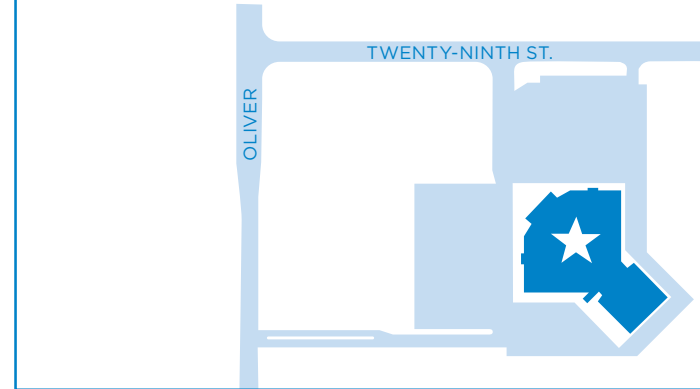
Hotel Accommodations

Program Objectives
